## **Basketball Games**

Our first basketball games of the season are this week. B-Team games vs. St. Peter (Weyauwega) are this Wednesday (1/13) at 4:30 at SVLS, and A-Team games at Weyauwega are this Friday (1/15). A-Teams will be dismissed from their classrooms at 3:10 on Friday.

- + Each player is allowed, at most, two spectator guests. The only exception is if there are multiple children playing on the same night, the other players don't count toward the player's two spectators.
- + Masks are required upon entry. There are no exceptions.
- + After the first game, we will ask everyone to vacate the building. During this time, we will disinfect bleachers and benches, and we will welcome you back in when the disinfecting is completed.
- + While we won't be telling you where to sit, please be considerate of physical distancing guidelines when choosing where in the bleachers to sit.

## **Scrip – What's the big deal???**

The scrip program was able to order Kwik Trip BONUS cards at the 21%. If you are ordering online, search for "Kwik Trip BONUS". If you order via paper orders, Kwik Trip cards will be filled with the bonus cards as long as they are available.

Scrip allows you to earn rebates which can be applied to your child(ren)'s tuition balance, all by doing your regular shopping!

How significant can this savings be? After 7 months of scrip/gift card ordering, there are 7 school families that have already saved over \$200 to be applied to their tuition account (or have chosen cash back) for next school year! There are also a few grandparents that faithfully order scrip/gift cards and have saved over \$100 for their grandchildren's education.

It's not too late to get started and to lower your tuition bill for the next school year! (If you do not have a tuition bill, you can choose the cash back option. Your check is sent to you in July - perfect timing for back-to-school shopping!)




## Book Donation Requirements
