K-8 EDP Leader

SVLS is looking for someone to serve as our Extended Day Program (EDP) leader. The commitment for this position would be 15-25 hours per week and would involve working every weekday morning and afternoon. SVLS will pay an hourly wage based on qualifications and experience. Hot Lunch Coordinator and Cook

SVLS is looking for a qualified individual to serve as our school hot lunch coordinator and cook. The commitment for this position would be 15-25 hours per week when school is in session and would primarily involve planning well-rounded, nutritious meals; purchasing the food; and preparing and serving the meals. (This position could potentially be split into two positions: Cook, and Grocery Shopper). This person will also need to be (or become) familiar with health and food safety standards. This position is considered a contracted position. A job description and application can be obtained from the SVLS K-8 office.

Financial Manager

SVLS is hiring a Financial Manager to assist with the accounting functions of the school. We anticipate this part-time position will require between 10-20 hours per week. Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP)

The application window for WPCP opens today and will remain open through April 15. Families who are currently receiving WPCP vouchers need to complete the online application at www.dpi.wi.gov/choice and provide the school with proof of residency in order to keep the voucher for next year. You do not need to reverify income. You will not lose your voucher unless you do not re-apply.

If you didn't qualify for WPCP last year, but your 2020 income was lower than 2019, you might be eligible to apply. And this year again, SVLS families with children at any grade level are eligible to apply for WPCP and receive a voucher. Compare your 2020 income with the published income limits to see if you'd qualify. The attachment to last week's Partnership Post with all the information about that can be found here. Private School Tax Deduction

Wisconsin state law allows Wisconsin parents to deduct private school tuition on their taxes. Under this law, parents statewide can deduct up to \$4,000 per student in grades K-8, and up to \$10,000 per high school student. In order to complete Schedule PS, you will need the following information:



We are in the "frontier" area of Mexico, and the only Lutheran church on the entire Yucatan Peninsula, an area of 5 million people. While we are WELS affiliated, Costa Maya Ministries is a "labor of love" started in 2007 and operated by a groups of WELS lay people. By God's grace we are growing!

This is our pastor, Pastor Martin Valleskey. He's served our congregation, Cristo de Crux (Cross of Christ) Lutheran Church. Pastor Valleskey arrived in 2015 and brought his guitar with him. What a blessing, as we presently worship in rented space under a covered roof – no place for an organ here! But the congregation has purchased land in 2018 and is having an architect draw its first church as this is written. We pray you and your children will get to know us, your fellow Christians at Costa Maya, and personally feel a part of the Lord's work in a distant place!

IN EDUCATION — We are thrilled to share that in June 2019 the Lord blessed us with an interim education director, Christopher Dean, an graduate of Martin Luther College. In addition to teaching English to future "tourist" workers, he is also teaching Spanish to children who have not had the opportunity to attend school.
