Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP)

The application window for WPCP is now open and will remain open through April 15. Families who are currently receiving WPCP vouchers need to complete the online application at www.dpi.wi.gov/choice and provide the school

with proof of residency in order to keep the voucher for next year. You do not need to re-verify income. You will not lose your voucher unless you do not re-apply.

If you didn't qualify for WPCP last year, but your 2020 income was lower than 2019, you might be eligible to apply. And this year again, SVLS families with children at any grade level are eligible to apply for WPCP and receive a voucher. Compare your 2020 income with the published income limits to see if you'd qualify. The attachment to a previous Partnership Post with all the information about that can be found here. And, as always, please contact Mr. Steinmetz if you think you might be eligible, or if you have any questions regarding the application process.

If you would like to fill out the online application at school, that is completely fine! Please contact Mr. Steinmetz to set up a time and date to do that.

Private School Tax Deduction

Wisconsin state law allows Wisconsin parents to deduct private school tuition on their taxes. Under this law, parents statewide can deduct up to \$4,000 per student in grades K-8, and up to \$10,000 per high school student. K-8 EDP Leader

SVLS is looking for someone to serve as our Extended Day Program (EDP) leader. The commitment for this position would be 15-25 hours per week and would involve working every weekday morning and afternoon. SVLS will pay an hourly wage based on qualifications and experience. Hot Lunch Coordinator and Cook

SVLS is looking for a qualified individual to serve as our school hot lunch coordinator and cook. The commitment for this position would be 15-25 hours per week when school is in session and would primarily involve planning well-rounded, nutritious meals; purchasing the food; and preparing and serving the meals. (This position could potentially be split into two positions: Cook, and Grocery Shopper). This person will also need to be (or become) familiar with health and food safety standards. Financial Manager

SVLS is hiring a Financial Manager to assist with the accounting functions of the school. We anticipate this part-time position will require between 10-20 hours per week. With us being part-way through the 3rd Quarter, we'd like to get together with you and discuss your child's progress in a scheduled Parent-Teacher conference. Like our first set of conferences this year back in September/October, the nature of these conferences would be more formative, focusing on areas of strength in your child(ren) as well as areas we've noticed for improvement. Unlike our 1st Quarter conferences, these conferences are **optional**, to be requested by either you or your child(ren)'s teacher(s). If you request a conference, your child(ren)'s teacher(s) will gladly oblige. Similarly, if a teacher requests a conference with you, we ask that you return the same courtesy. We have the following two days scheduled for these optional 15 minute conferences:

Thursday February 25, 4:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. Friday February 26, 10:30 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.

Please select the teacher(s) with whom you'd like to have a conference. Please also indicate the specific area(s) you'd like to focus on in the conference. If you are absolutely unable to make one of the scheduled time frames work, please contact your child(ren)'s teacher(s) to schedule a separate conference.

Please return this form to school <u>on or before Tuesday, February 16, 2021</u>. The faculty will be meeting shortly after Tuesday the 16th to arrange the conference schedule, and your scheduled conference time will be communicated to you later that week or early the following week.

Once again, we are offering you the option of having your conference virtually via Google Meet or in-person. If you choose in person, we will maintain at least 6 ft. of distancing, tables/chairs will be disinfected between conferences, teachers will be wearing face coverings, and we'd ask that you would as well. We also ask that you not bring your child(ren) with you to these conferences, in order to minimize contact for all parties involved. In the event that your conference would need to be different than your indicated preference, that will be communicated to you.
