### **COVID-19 Revised Quarantine Durations**

Recently the CDC revised its guidance regarding the duration of a quarantine period after an exposure to someone who had COVID-19. The Wisconsin DHS adopted the revisions, and earlier this week I had a meeting with the Calumet County Health Department to go over these revisions. At the December 8, 2020 SVLS School Board meeting, it was decided that SVLS would also follow the revised quarantine guidance, reducing the duration of the quarantine period from 14 days to 10 days, beginning on Monday, December 14, 2020. Full details of the revised quarantine protocols can be found in our <u>Revised</u> Quarantine Duration Plan, which also was sent out to our school families via email.

The SVLS School Board met for its monthly business meeting last Tuesday, December 8. Highlights of this meeting include:

+ Approval to move forward with the revised quarantine duration guidance from DHS.

+ Reviewed our recent school safety drill, as well as our school's Emergency Preparedness Plan.

+ Agreement to continue in our partnership with FVLHS under ACT 59 for our second year of participation in WPCP (School Choice), to allow families with students at any grade level (even existing SVLS families) to apply for WPCP.

+ Approval of the <u>2021-2022 school year</u> <u>calendar</u> (attached to the Post, along with approved tuition rates for 2021-2022).

#### **Classroom Christmas Parties and Gift Exchanges**

The teachers have been discussing how to go about having a classroom Christmas party and what to do about Christmas gifts for this school year. After some good discussion and weighing the options, here is what we decided to do:

+ Christmas Party Snacks - Instead of asking you to buy or bring something food-related this year, we're asking that, if you're willing, to donate a few dollars to your child's classroom. Then the teachers will go shopping and purchase food for the classroom Christmas parties. We ask that if you're going to donate a couple dollars for this, you get the money to the teachers by the end of next week (December 18). + Christmas Gifts - We have been in contact with the Hope Center here in Appleton, a branch of WELS United and located on the campus of St. Matthew's Lutheran Church. This year, in place of a student-tostudent gift exchange, we are asking the children to consider donating a gift (or gifts) to the Hope Center. Prior to COVID, the Hope Center typically had 30-40 families per month who were in need that came to them. In November 2020 alone, they had 120 families come to them in need of some help!

This Christmas, please consider sharing the blessings you have with other families in the Fox Valley who don't have as much as you do. The biggest needs the families have right now are daily necessities such as body wash, shampoo/conditioner, toothpaste, toilet paper, hand soap, liquid dish detergent, bleach wipes, diapers, and baby wipes. Additionally, reading books or crafts for children would be appreciated. All items should be new and in store packaging. They also ask that nothing be gift wrapped. We are asking that your child(ren) bring any gifts to school by December 18 to give the Hope Center sufficient time to make them ready for their families. Thank you for considering this Christmas giving opportunity through SVLS to the Hope Center!

# SVLS 2021-2022 Tuition Payment Policy

Tuition will be paid according to one of the following options:

- Option 1 **Single Payment** due August 3, 2021 (K-8 registration day) made directly to the SVLS. 3% discount per K-8 student will apply <u>only if payment is received by August 3, 2021</u>. Preschool's single payment would be due by Preschool registration day in order to receive the 3% discount.
- Option 2 **Monthly, weekly, or semimonthly payments** beginning September 2021 through June 2022 automatically withdrawn from the family's bank account through the Simply Giving program.
- Option 3 **Special payment program** <u>only if approved by the SVLS school board by</u> <u>August 3, 2021</u>. Whenever there is a need to arrange for a different payment plan from Option 1 or Option 2 above, SVLS should be contacted immediately.

The desired option should be noted on the Application for Admission Form. Students will not be approved for enrollment at SVLS unless one of the three options above have been approved and processed by August 3, 2021.

## **REGISTRATION FEES DUE AT TIME OF APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION**

Based on the commitment by each family, SVLS reserves a seat in the classroom for the student and prepares for that student by ordering the appropriate books, supplies, etc. needed to educate the child.

A \$150 non-refundable registration fee per student is required with submission of the Application for Admission Form. This amount will be applied to the tuition fee. Checks may be made payable to Shepherd of the Valley Lutheran School. The maximum non-refundable registration fee per family is \$300.

Families who currently participate in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) are exempt from the registration fee. If a family does not currently participate in WPCP but potentially will in the upcoming school year, the registration fee should be submitted to SVLS, but it will be returned upon WPCP qualification.

Students put on a waiting list will have the non-refundable registration fee reimbursed if there is no available seat in the classroom for the student.

There will be a nonrefundable registration fee of \$10 for students using the Extended Day Program.

### NON-PAYMENT POLICY

If payment is returned due to insufficient funds, the family will pay any fees incurred by SVLS for each payment returned by the bank.

When tuition is two months overdue, a letter will be issued indicating steps to be taken should tuition not be brought up to date.

When tuition is three months overdue, a letter will be sent indicating that the child may be excluded from class and all school related activities at the discretion of SVLS School Board until the tuition debt is satisfied or special arrangements have been made.
